The Wayne County Board of Commissioners meeting was called to order by Chairman Terry Sievers at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, in the Wayne County Courtroom. Chairman Sievers, Members Dean Burbach and Jim Rabe, and Clerk Joni Tietz were present. Notice of this meeting was published in the Wayne Herald, a legal newspaper, on November 7, 2024. A copy of the Open Meetings Act was posted and accessible to the public.

Chairman Sievers presented the following consent agenda items:

- a. Approve November 5, 2024 minutes as printed in the Commissioners Record
- b. Approve payroll; commissioners abstain from approving personal claim
- c. Approve fee reports: Joni Tietz, County Clerk, October fees, \$10,546.75; Jason Dwinell, County Sheriff, October fees, \$1280.50

Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Rabe and seconded by Burbach. Roll call vote: Rabe, Burbach, Sievers - aye; motion carried.

The regular agenda was approved on a motion made by Burbach and seconded by Rabe. Roll call vote: Burbach, Rabe, Sievers-aye; motion carried.

Commissioner Burbach stated that a lot of decisions had to be made to replace the water line from the Courthouse; therefore, he recommended that an experienced company provide specs for a bidding process. Chairman Sievers requested Commissioner Burbach contact a company for that purpose.

Highway Superintendent, Kyle Huff, appeared before the board to award the bid for the CBMP(7) project. B's Enterprises, having low bid, met all criteria for the project. Therefore, he recommended the Board award the bid to B's Enterprises for \$307,014.60 for all five projects. In breaking down the bid it was reported District 2 had a cost of \$73,558.75 and District 3 had a cost of \$63,109.05. The other three projects are in Madison County. On motion made by Burbach and seconded by Rabe the low bid was awarded to B's Enterprises. Roll call vote: Burbach, Rabe, Sievers-aye. Motion carried.
