The Wayne County Board of Commissioner meeting was called to order by Chairman James Rabe at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, in the Wayne County Courthouse Courtroom. Chairman Rabe, Members Terry Sievers and Dean Burbach, Clerk Joni Tietz were present. Notice of this meeting was published in the Wayne Herald, a legal newspaper, on January 9, 2025. A copy of the Open Meetings Act was posted and accessible to the public.

Chairman Rabe presented the following consent agenda items:

- a. Act on January 17, 2025 minutes as printed in the Commissioners Record
- b. Act on payroll; commissioners abstain from approving personal claim
- c. Act on fee reports: Jason Dwinell, Wayne County Sheriff-\$940.30; Joni Tietz, Wayne County Clerk-\$33,634.00

Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Sievers and seconded by Burbach. Roll call vote: Sievers, Burbach, Rabe- aye; motion carried.

The regular agenda was approved on a motion made by Sievers and seconded by Burbach. Roll call vote: Sievers, Burbach, Rabe-aye; motion carried.

Julie Schultz, UNL Extension, appeared before the board to inform them of the new Extension Board Members- Trevor Sullivan, Brent Svoboda, Barb Hochstein. Sievers moved that the Board approve the appointment of the new Extension members with Burbach seconding the motion. Roll call vote: Sievers, Burbach, Rabe-aye. Motion carried. Schultz also informed the board that she will be ordering a new computer as required by the University of Nebraska.

Kyle Huff, Wayne County Highway Superintendent, received quotes on the District 3 snowblower. The lowest quote came in from Midwest Service & Sales for \$17,395 after trade. Burbach made a motion to approve the quote and affecting Claim #250100120 to be approved. Rabe seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Burbach, Sievers, Rabe-aye; motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Kyle Huff then highlighted information from bridge inspection training. Bridges under 30 feet need to be remeasured. Huff will coordinate with Thurston County regarding quality control inspections. Huff also explained to the Board that nineteen bridges need to be in the 1 year plan and emphasized that core permits are required if a structure changes at all. The 1 and 6 year hearing will be in February. Beginning in March Federal Highway has a new set of rules as well as the State of Nebraska.
